### CONTENUTI DISCIPLINARI

**UNIT 9 TALENT:** Grammar: Present perfect form, Past simple vs Present perfect, Present perfect with *just-already-yet*. Reading: Top summer holidays for teens. Vocabulary: phrasal verbs and expressions about travelling. Listening: Teens need more time. Functions: asking and giving directions.

**UNIT 10 TALENT:** Grammar: Present perfect with *for* and *since*. Listening: Ghost walk. Vocabulary: *to get*, labelling a diagram. Functions: making arrangements.

**UNIT 1 BOTH SIDES IDENTITY:** Grammar: Present simple vs Present continuous, Past simple vs Past continuous, ability in the present and past. Vocabulary: personal description, experiences. Functions: Adding information. Reading: Vive la difference, Never give up!

**UNIT 2 BOTH SIDES THE ENVIRONMENT:** Grammar: used to, subject vs object questions, Past perfect and narrative tenses. Vocabulary: conservation, natural phenomena. Functions: contrasting ideas. Reading: Saving the planet to save ourselves, Nature in Greek mythology, Britain's endangered red squirrels. Writing: story writing.

**UNIT 3 BOTH SIDES SOCIAL CIRCLES:** Grammar: Present perfect, Present perfect with *how long-for-since*, Present perfect continuous. Vocabulary: relationships, interacting. Functions: confirming and contradicting. Reading: Six degrees of separation, Money problems.

**UNIT 4 BOTH SIDES TOO MUCH STUFF:** Grammar: Verbs of perception, Present and past participles as adjectives, adverbs of manner and degree. Vocabulary: consumer products, producer to consumer.
